

## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS FOR SFL UNDERGRADUATE ENGLISH PROGRAMME STUDENTS

### **Do I have to choose a UEP course?**

ENGL1101 and ENGL1102 are compulsory for all English medium students. Students of International Relations are also required to take ENGL2101 and ENGL2102 upon completion of ENGL1102. Students of Psychology and Management of Information Technologies are also required to take ENGL2103 and ENGL2104 upon completion of ENGL1102.

### **What skills are studied in ENGL1101/ENGL1102/etc.?**

UEP courses focus on the essential reading and writing skills required for academic study. Full details of each course can be found on the university website.

### **What level can I achieve at the end of the undergraduate program?**

Students who successfully complete the undergraduate programme can expect to achieve a level of B2-C1

### **How can I be exempt from Freshman ENGL1101?**

If an incoming student obtains a passing score from ENGL1101 Exemption Test or presents the score from any of the following senate-approved TOEFL exam centres, or ÖSYM (Measurement, Selection, and Placement Centre), s/he will have the right to exemption from ENGL1101 and will proceed directly to ENGL1102.

Exemption is only possible from ENGL1101. All EMI undergraduate students must complete ENGL1102, and EMI students of Psychology, Management, International Relations and Management of Information Technologies must also complete ENGL 2103/2104 and ENGL 2101/2102 respectively in order to graduate.

### **How many hours of class time can I be absent from my ENGL101 and ENGL102 classes?**

Students must attend a minimum of 70% of class time and fulfill the requirements of all assessment procedures in order to pass any UEP course.

**I failed to pass ENGL1101; will I be allowed to take ENGL1102 during the next semester?**

No, it is a prerequisite. Students must pass ENGL1101 in order to progress to ENGL1102.

**Are ENGL1 101 and/or ENGL1102 courses given during the summer?**

Yes, ENGL1101 and ENGL1102 run during the fall, spring and summer semesters.

**I'm already enrolled in an ENGL section, but now I need to change my class to a different section. Is this possible?**

Students may change their sections within the first three weeks of the semester.

**I need to speak to my English teacher; do they have office hours when I can visit them?**

Yes, all UEP instructors have set office hours. Students will be informed of their instructor's office hours in class and via BB.

**Do I have to buy the required textbooks?**

Yes, students will be informed of which textbook is required and where it can be purchased during course orientation sessions.

**I am a student of a Turkish medium programme, do I have to choose ENGL1201 and 1202 courses?**

Yes, these courses are compulsory. However, students sit "the placement test" at the beginning of the academic year. If a student gets 30 and above, s/he can be exempted from ENGL1201, if s/he gets 45 and above s/he can be exempted from ENGL1202.

**I took ENGL1201 and failed. Can I sit the placement test again?**

No, you can take it only once and at the beginning of the academic year.

**Is attendance mandatory?**

Yes. Students have to attend at least 70 % of the courses. Otherwise they fail.
