Instructor Tefik Taylan Tüzün, MA was born in Üsküdar in 1946. He studied elementary school at Namik Kemal Elementary School in Ankara and middle and high school at Ankara Atatürk High School. He graduated from high school in 1964. After studying at English preparation school at Middle East Technical University for one year, he graduated from the graduate school of Architecture of Istanbul Fine Arts Academy of the State in 1973.

He started working at Architecture offices during his student years at the Academy. After his graduation, he worked at the offices of architects such as, Sedat Hakkı Eldem, EPA (Mehmet Çubuk, Nihat Güner, Ersen Gürsel partnership) and Vedat Atilla.

He entered the Vocational Upper School of Fine Arts Academy as an assistant in 1975. He began instructing here in 1991. Until his retirement from Mimar Sinan Fine Arts University in 2005, he managed “Final Construction” and “Wood Technology” courses at the Vocational School “Structure”, “Final Construction” and “Project” courses at the department of Architecture and “Final Construction” and “Furniture Application” courses at the Interior Architecture Department.

Other than his work at the school, he began doing furniture and decoration works by opening up a workshop since 1982. In this field, he took role in such works as Turgutreis Odak Holiday Resort’s furniture, VIP hall of Sabancı Holding, doors and kitchens of Kopa Insaat’s Serencebey apartments, exhibition booths, Koc University Istinye campus gym and various works of the library and Koc University Nursing Vocational Upper School’s repair and modifications.

Taylan Tüzün who has been working as an instructor at Yeditepe University since 2001 is still working in Interior Architecture Department at Fine Arts Faculty in Isik University.
